The Playhouse is open year-round for children 5 and under, and the Playground is open April – October for children 10 and under. Admission is free. SMITH is easily accessible from Kelly Drive, Route 76, or SEPTA bus #32 which stops at the Fairmount Park entrance at 33rd and Oxford Streets.
